## Customizing the Automated Text Message Response

Due to strict TCPA regulations, organizations cannot change the initial text when a donor texts in to your donation keyword. However, there is an easy workaround.

Instead of asking donors to use your Text to Donate keyword, you can use the Text to Donate form but instruct people to text an SMS Subscription keyword instead, that will respond with a One-Time Response that can be fully customized.

1. Go to the form you want to direct supporters to and copy the Shareable Link (Public Link) from the Display Links box on the lower left.

Folks who pledge **will not** receive **Fulfillment Reminder Texts**. For pledges made using a Text to Donate keyword on 41444 or 91999, up to three reminder messages are automatically sent until the pledger completes their donation. Using the SMS Subscription method, they will receive none.
