- 2. Cut and paste your page URL (e.g. https://fundraise.givesmart.com/e/dGHNpQ) and click **Debug**.
- If a logo is not appearing correctly try uploading a 500x500 logo to your form. (You can hide it if you like and add the exact logo using a custom image in a custom field.)
- 4. The Facebook share title and description defaults to your **Campaign** name and description.
 - The Description can be changed within the **Social Media Settings** of the activity, but the name/title will stay as the Campaign name.
- 5. You can edit these settings inside the Campaign:
 - Click the Settings icon on the Campaign tile
 - In Settings within the campaign, open the Properties section
 - Edit the Campaign Name and Description
